

# GRAND CANYON NATIONAL PARK SERVICE

## 2007 ENTRANCE FEES

**THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE REQUIRES THAT ALL GRAND CANYON OUTFITTERS COLLECT ENTRANCE FEES FROM ALL PARTICIPANTS OF WHITE-WATER TRIPS ORIGINATING AT LEES FERRY. PERSONS ON THE LOWER CANYON TRIPS WILL PAY AN ENTRANCE FEE WHEN THEY ENTER THE PARK AT THE SOUTH RIM.**

To facilitate the orderly collection of fees and minimize disruption of your river trip when you arrive in Page, Arizona – Wilderness River Adventures has elected to add the fee to your statement. Please advise our office if you feel your entrance fees are not correct. If you own a GOLDEN EAGLE PASS or a GOLDEN AGE PASS we will need a copy of the card. Please mail it in with your Acknowledge of Risk form or your Final Payment.

Following is the National Park Service Fee Collection Categories and Fee Exemptions:

**FEE COLLECTIONS:**

Individuals (17 years of age and older).....\$12.00 each

**FEE EXEMPTIONS:**

Individuals (16 years of age and under)

Golden Age Passport – Golden Eagle – Golden Access or Grand Canyon Passport

**(The passport will admit the holder and their immediate family)**

**Immediate family is defined as – spouse / children / parents**

Please advise Wilderness River Adventures if you have one of the above passports and how many persons in your party it covers. Please send a photocopy of your card with your Acknowledgement of Risk or your final payment. Deduct the entrance fee if listed on your statement.

**PASSENGERS ON UPPER CANYON TRIPS (LEES FERRY TO PHANTOM RANCH)**

Who either leave their car at the South Rim prior to arriving in Page – have their car shuttled from Page to the South Rim – or dropped off in Page and picked up at the South Rim – will not be charged a NPS FEE by Wilderness, as NPS FEES are collected at the South Rim when you enter the Park.
