- Be knowledgeable of State, U.S. Coast Guard and National Park Service regulations applicable to boats carrying passengers for hire.
- Be knowledgeable of each parks natural and human history – points of interest encountered – and the ability and willingness to impart this knowledge to passengers.
- Must possess a current certification in Wilderness First Responder or a current certification in Emergency Medical Technician credentials.
- Must possess a current certification in CPR.
- Must possess a valid Commercial Operation Requirement Certification for guide status or Utah Guides License.
- Must have a working knowledge of all environmental protection equipment and sanitation procedures for river trips in the National Park.

Your trip leaders and guides will make your adventure safe, comfortable and memorable.

IT IS NOT TOO EARLY TO BEGIN THINKING ABOUT NEXT YEAR. The sooner you get into the booking process, the more likely you are to get the exact trip you want. If you write, give us the following information:

1. The type of expedition you desire (trip length / motor / oar).
2. The number of persons in your group.
3. The approximate month you would like to depart. If possible, indicate more than one choice.

Your name will then be placed in our priority trip book. Once our schedule is completed and approved by the National Park Service – you will be notified of the trips we have available during the time period you requested.


